The above clinics have signed an agreement with the Animal Rescue League to offer regular spay/neuter at specific prices, and provide clients with a complementary 48-hour veterinarian check-up. **Clients who deal with veterinarians other than listed will have their surgery fee refunded directly from the League upon receipt of veterinarian signed surgery slip. The cost (if any) of additional veterinary services is the client's financial responsibility.**

Complementary Veterinarian Examination and Conditions

Within 48 hours of adoption you are required to have your animal examined by a veterinarian. This is for your pet's protection.

If there is a medical problem with the animal at this time you have two options:

1. To return the animal to the shelter and choose another one or receive a refund.
2. To keep the animal with the understanding that the League is not responsible for any veterinarian costs incurred by you.

In either case the League should be notified of any health problems that arise during this 48-hour examination. Failure on your part to have the 48-hour vet check done cancels either of the above options.

All animals adopted from the Animal Rescue League are to be spayed/neutered by the age of four months. If the animal adopted is four months of age or older they must be done within 30 days of adoption, the only exception to this rule is a delay from the veterinarian for medical reasons that the surgery would put the animal at risk.

Your veterinarian will discuss the spay/neuter procedure with you. If for any reason, the procedure is more complicated than a regular spay/neuter surgery, additional costs may be incurred. **THESE ADDITIONAL COSTS WILL BE PAID BY YOU, DIRECTLY TO YOUR VETERINARIAN.**
